

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-3

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2025-8
OF THE TOWN OF GENEVA, INDIANA, LIMITING HOLIDAY PAY TO
FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES AND THE DEPUTY CLERK-TREASURER**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Geneva, Indiana (the “Town Council”) previously adopted Ordinance No. 2025-8, as amended by Ordinance No. 2026-2, which fixes the salaries, compensation, benefit programs, and clothing allowances of the appointed officers and employees of the Town of Geneva, Indiana (the “Town”) for the 2026 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council now desires to amend the “Holiday” subsection of Section VIII of Ordinance No. 2025-8.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Geneva, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION I

The “Holiday” subsection of Section VIII of Ordinance No. 2025-8 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Holiday:

Subject to Policy No. 305 of the Town Employee Handbook, eligible full-time employees and the Deputy Clerk-Treasurer may receive paid holiday time off for the following fourteen (14) holidays: New Year’s Day; Martin Luther King Jr. Day; Presidents Day; Good Friday; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day; Columbus Day; Veterans Day; Thanksgiving Day; the Friday after Thanksgiving Day; Christmas Eve; Christmas Day; and New Year’s Eve.

SECTION II

All ordinances, or parts thereof, that are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III

If any section, clause, provision, paragraph, or sentence of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not affect the

validity of the other remaining provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall become and remain in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
