The Council President asked those present to please rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

President, Agnes Schoch, called the meeting to order. Roll call showed Council members, Gary Hendershot, Arlen Mitchel, Jim Timmons, Clerk-Treasurer Tony Davidson, present.

Clerk Treasurer Tony Davidson presented the Geneva Town council with the budget numbers that are in gateway but not finalized. It was on a simple spreadsheet, that had projected numbers for the end of the 2022 and beginning 2023 projected numbers. He advised that the growth quotient was at 5%.

Agnes Schoch asked what determined the miscellaneous revenue, Tony Davidson advised it was a variety of things and will present the council the answer at the next budget meeting.

Agnes advised that the budget did included a police vehicle using a USDA grant, purchasing a new chassis for water superintendent, and building for MVH to replace the tent and tech upgrades for all departments. Tony Davidson advised that county has been advised that it would be a few years to complete the process.

Discussion was held on Safety Loit Money and keeping the accumulation funds growing instead of spending out of it.

Arlen Mitchel discussed having the township fire contract money pay for the extra loan payment.


Gary Hendershot asked what percentage of a raise the town employees could expect to receive. Tony Davidson advised that he was looking at 3% raise across the board for elected officials and all town employees.

Gary Hendershot asked if we could raise the part time worker clothing allowance from \$250 to \$500 as the pair of boots doesn't cost any less for the part time employee.

Tony Davidson informed the council about needing to do a sewage and water study to raise the rates. Agnes said she would contact Baker Tilley and have them contact me.

Gary Hendershot asked about the trash contract and when it would need to be bid out for another contract.

On a motion by Arlen Mitchel, 2nd by Gary Hendershot and passed unanimously, the meeting was adjourned.


